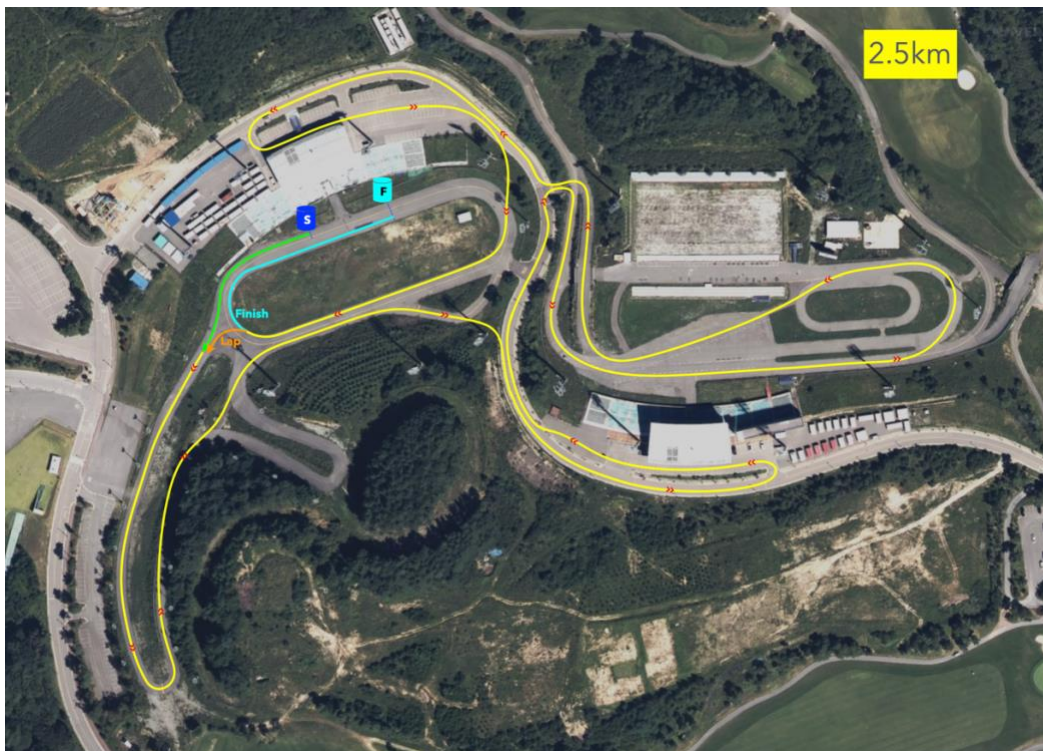

Venue Information: This venue hosted the PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympics and the Gangwon 2024 Winter Youth Olympic Games, and has also been the site of annual national roller ski competitions. The roller ski course consists of two loops: 1 km and 2.5 km.

Request for Team Information for Participation

In preparation for your team's participation in the competition, we kindly request the following information:

1. Flight details: including arrival and departure times and dates
2. Accommodation details : number of people, dates of stay, and number of rooms required

This information will be shared with the hotel, restaurant, and transportation service providers to support coordination. Please note that all related costs must be borne by each team. The Organizing Committee (OC) will only facilitate hotel room reservations and meal arrangements with the respective service providers.

4. For transportation: The Organizing Committee will support the transport of athletes to and from the Games and transport to the venue.

Accommodations and Meals

We would like to extend our sincere appreciation to all participating teams and athletes in the FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup 2026.

To ensure a pleasant and comfortable stay throughout the competition, we are pleased to provide detailed information regarding accommodation and meals for all team officials and athletes.

Kindly note that accommodation fees are to be paid upon check-in, and meal expenses should be settled directly at the restaurant at the time of dining. Payment is accepted by card and Korean cash.

Transportation

The Organizing Committee plans to assist athletes with round-trip transportation to and from the competition and to the venues.

On August 2 and 3, the arrival dates, transportation from the airport to the accommodations will be provided on those specific days. On August 7 and 8, the departure dates, transportation from the accommodations to the airport will be provided on those specific days.

* However, since we cannot provide buses every hour for the airport-hotel round trip, we plan to offer a total of two transportation services: one in the morning and one in the afternoon. (Detailed operating hours will be provided later, based on each country's flight arrival and departure schedules.)

1. Teams arriving on days when the Organizing Committee does not provide arrival or departure services may use international taxis. If you wish to use an international taxi, please indicate this in the final question of the Google Form.

2. Direct international taxi service from the airport to the accommodation.

If you use an international taxi for a direct trip from the airport to the accommodation, the following options are available (we will only assist with reservations upon request):

A Republic of Korea Visa may be required for each person traveling into Korea. Please check with your government consulate to see if you require a Visa to enter. Also, Please inform the Organizing Committee so that we can send an invitation by name to your federation.

Pre-Competition Checklist

Please review the following information and check all items once confirmed.

1. Competition Registration
 - Participating teams must complete the FIS online entry form and submit it via email to furumelee@naver.com by the registration deadline.
2. Equipment Preparation
 - All participants are required to bring their own roller skis, helmet, goggles, gloves, boots, and other personal equipment.
 - The Organizing Committee will provide Official roller skis(FF Roller Ski) on the Official Training and Competition days.
3. Team Captains' Meeting (TCM)

- Competition-related information will be provided during the Team Captains' Meeting on August 4, and attendance by the team representative is mandatory.
- 4. Accident & Insurance
 - In the event of an accident at the venue, first aid and hospital transport will be provided. However, any further medical treatment at the hospital must be paid for by the injured person.
 - The Organizing Committee has arranged event insurance, but all participants must also have their own personal insurance coverage.
