Participants

1. Each National Ski Association (NSA) may enter a maximum of six (6) athletes per discipline for the FIS Roller Ski Asian Championships (ROLASC) 2026. All athletes must hold a valid FIS Code and must be entered exclusively through their respective National Ski Association (NSA).

3. Only National Ski Associations are entitled to submit entries. Entries submitted by individual athletes, ski clubs, or private teams will not be accepted.

4. All athletes must comply with the eligibility rules of the FIS Entry must be sent by the official FIS application form

Entries

1. Entries by number must be submitted no later than **23 August 2026** to:
services@ssat.or.th (CC: dep.sec@ssat.or.th).
2. Entries by name must be submitted no later than **06 September 2026** to: services@ssat.or.th
(CC: dep.sec@ssat.or.th).
3. All entries must be submitted through the respective National Ski Association (NSA).
4. Entries by name must be submitted using the official FIS application form. The type of ski binding (SNS or NNN) must be specified for each athlete.
5. Changes to entries by name after the deadline are subject to approval by the Organizing Committee.
6. Late entries may not be accepted.
7. Athletes from outside the Asian region are not eligible to participate.

Accommodation (Preliminary Information)

The official hotel for the FIS Roller Ski Asian Championships 2026 is **Together Kaeng Krachan Resort**, Phetchaburi.

Full Board accommodation rates (per person per night) are as follows:

- Single Room: **EUR 120**
- Twin Room: **EUR 75**
- Family Room (4 persons): **EUR 65**

Family Room consists of two connected bedrooms with two bathrooms and accommodates up to four persons.

The Full Board package includes accommodation, breakfast, lunch, dinner, local transportation between the official hotel and the competition venue, and complimentary access to the resort water park.

Teams wishing to book accommodation are kindly requested to complete and return the attached **Accommodation & Logistics Form (Excel file)** no later than **6 September 2026**.

Teams seeking more budget-friendly accommodation options are welcome to contact the Organizing Committee for further information and recommendations.

Transportation

Teams that book accommodation through the Organizing Committee (OC) – Ski and Snowboard Association of Thailand – will be provided with shuttle services from the airport to the official accommodation, as well as daily shuttle services between the accommodation and the competition venue during the event period.

Estimated travel times to Kaeng Krachan Circuit:

- From Suvarnabhumi Airport: approximately 3–3.5 hours
- From Don Mueang International Airport: approximately 3–3.5 hours

Official arrival transfer services will be available on **1–2 October 2026**, and official departure transfer services will be available on **7 October 2026**.

Teams arriving or departing outside these official transportation dates may still request transportation assistance from the Organizing Committee; however, additional transportation charges may apply.

To ensure smooth transportation arrangements, teams are kindly requested to provide their travel details, including arrival and departure times, number of participants, and baggage information, no later than **6 September 2026**.

Teams arranging their own accommodation may request transportation assistance from the Organizing Committee. Subject to availability, the OC can assist in arranging private transportation. An 8-seat van with driver is available at a rate of **EUR 65 per day** (fuel costs not included).

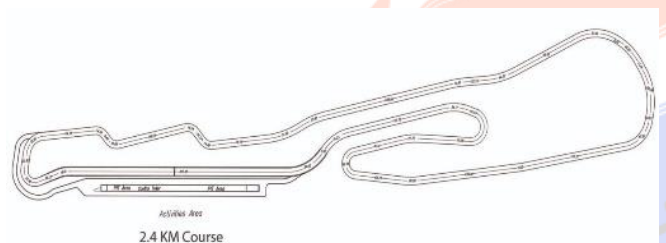
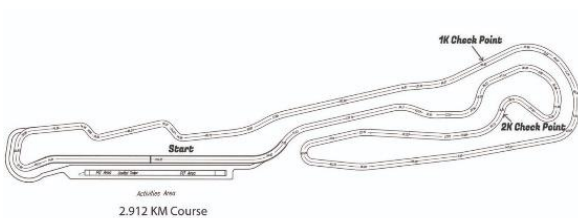

Competition Rules

1. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the FIS.
2. The FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup Rules shall apply as a basis for this event.
3. Specific regulations for the FIS Roller Ski Asian Championships (ROLASC) 2026 shall take precedence where applicable.
4. The International Competition Rules (ICR) – Cross-Country and FIS Roller Ski Rules (latest edition) shall apply.
5. All competitions within the ROLASC programmed will count towards the FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup Overall Standings.

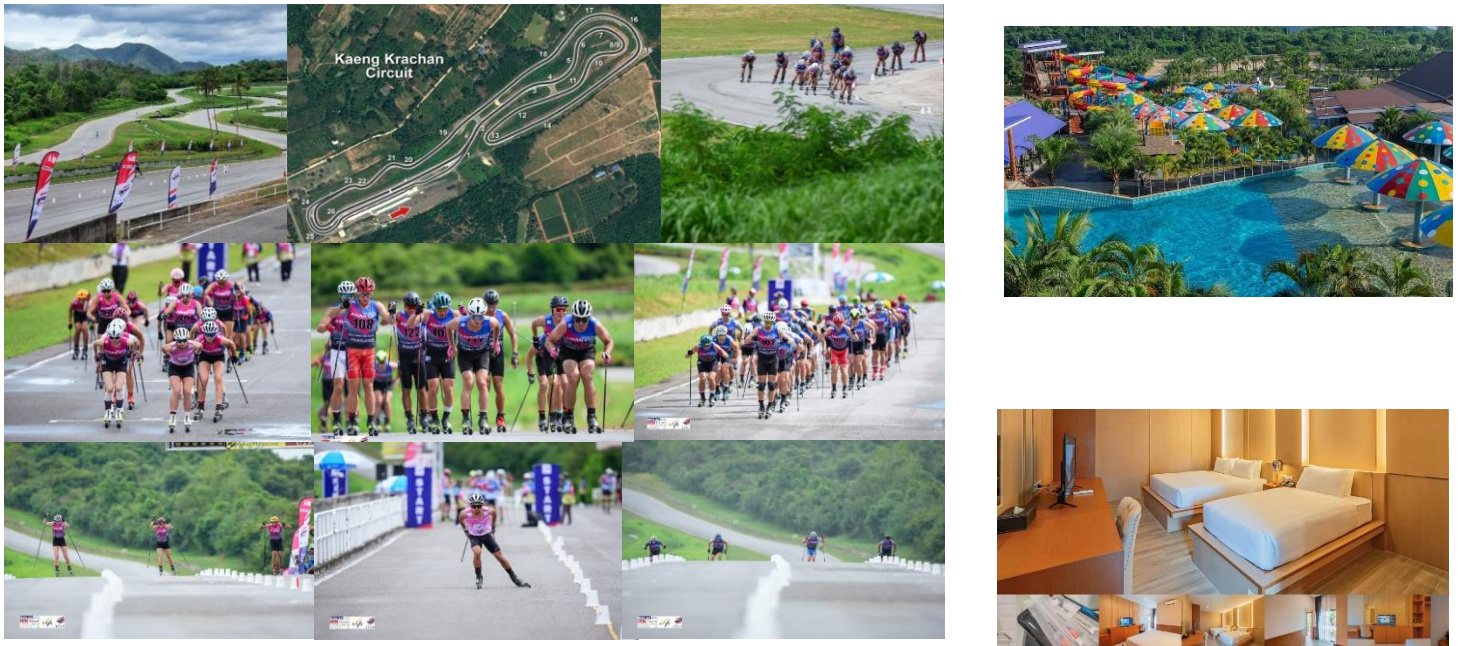
Equipment Regulations

1. According to ICR 396.2.6, only cross-country ski poles with appropriate tips are allowed.
2. Alternatively, pole tips must be fitted with rigid plastic safety protections (minimum diameter 30 mm, positioned maximum 45 mm above the tip).
